






Aoun Award for Community Service

Year 2024 - 2025

Abu Dhabi - Emirates Red Crescent HQ

From organizing 30 impactful initiatives to mobilizing over 1,200 volunteers and touching more than 6,500 lives, the Emirates Red Crescent Student Club at Ajman University has redefined student-led community service. This remarkable effort earned the club second place in the 13th Aoun Award for Community Service (2024–2025), a prestigious national honor organized by the Emirates Red Crescent Authority in partnership with the Ministry of Education. Under the guidance of the Office of Student Life and the supervision of the Community Service Unit, these students continue to lead with impact, turning compassion into meaningful action across the UAE.











Back to School Shopping

September 1, 2024 **Ajman City Centre - CenterPoint**

The Office of Community Engagement, in collaboration with the International Charity Organization, hosted a "Back to School Shopping" event at Ajman City Centre as part of Ajman University's welcome celebrations. Dedicated student volunteers helped children choose essential school supplies, including bags, stationery, and shoes, and each child received a 250 AED voucher. This initiative aimed to make a positive impact on the students' lives, offering them renewed hope and support for the new school year.











Back to School Packing & Distribution

Emirati Genome

November 12 - 13, 2024

Ajman University

The initiative encouraged Emirati students, faculty, and staff to volunteer by providing a single blood sample. The project aimed to use genomic data to improve the health of the Emirati population through scientific research. It focused on profiling and sequencing genes to enhance the prevention and treatment of chronic diseases.





Food ATM Distribution

Food ATM Kitchen

The Office of Community Engagement celebrated the International Day of Tolerance by collaborating with Food ATM Kitchen to distribute meals to over 660 workers after Friday prayers. Volunteers actively packed and handed out the meals, demonstrating community spirit and solidarity. 2 Campaigns - Food Packing & Distribution

Ramadan 2025 **Ajman University**

In the spirit of Ramadan and aligned with the Year of Community 2025, the Office of Community Engagement led a food packaging and distribution initiative to support campus workers. The College of Humanities and Sciences, led by Dr. Mahra Aal Malek, and the College of Mass Communication, led by Dr. Alyaa Anter, played vital roles, contributing to food security efforts for lower-income individuals. Volunteers from the AU Entrepreneurship Club also participated, helping pack and distribute 700 food boxes containing essential dry items such as oil, lentils, tuna, tomato paste, rice, macaroni, dates, cream, and Lebanese bread.





Arab Media Summit 2025

The College of Mass Communication at Ajman University organized a field visit to the Arab Media Summit 2025 in Dubai (May 26–28), involving students and alumni. The initiative aligns with Ajman University's mission to equip students with practical skills and prepare professionals to advance the media sector locally and regionally.







19 Visites for AU Mobile Dental Clinic

Year 2024 - 2025

Across UAE

The Mobile Dental Clinic, in collaboration with the Office of Community Engagement, conducted 19 visits across the UAE. Over the course of a year, Ajman University volunteers treated more than 1,800 patients at various locations. This project not only provided valuable opportunities for the University but also enhanced career prospects for students. Locations visited included Emaar Properties in Umm Al Quwain, Sharjah Charity International, Al Saja'a, Sharjah Humanitarian Services, and Al Zohour Private School in Sharjah, where over 150 patients received treatment and oral health education highlighting the importance of regular dental care for overall well-being.
